The small hamlet of Strathconon is an area of outstanding natural beauty. The plot is situated approximately twelve miles from Marybank, twenty miles from Dingwall and approximately a one hour's drive from Inverness city centre. Strathconon Primary School is located nearby. The area is popular with hill walkers and those enjoying other outdoor pursuits and is noted for a wide range of local wildlife.

LOCATION

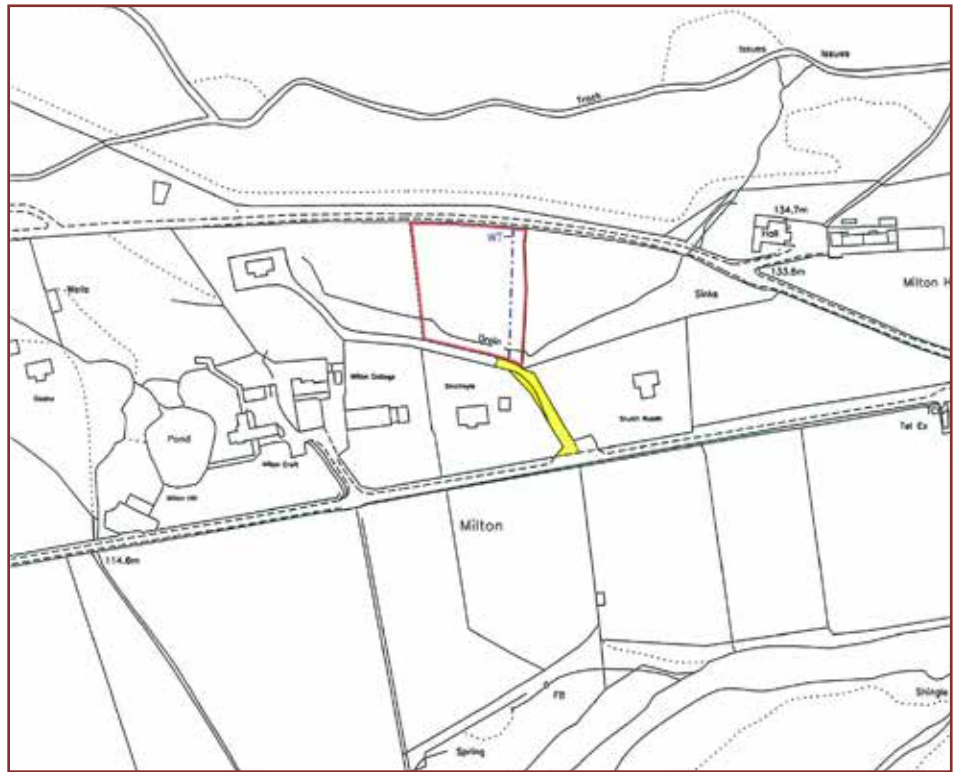
The building plot is situated in an elevated position with views over the River Meig and surrounding countryside.

PLANNING PERMISSION

Planning Permission has been obtained for the erection of a four bedroom dwellinghouse under reference 13/01125FUL dated 20th May 2013. A copy of this will be made available to interested parties.

SERVICES

Road access to the plot is by way of a private access road which has been constructed. Electric and telephone supplies are adjacent. Drainage will be by way of a private drainage system. It is anticipated that a private water supply will be obtained via a bore hole to be constructed on site by the purchaser.



DIRECTIONS

From the Dingwall to Ullapool A835 public road turn left and travel to Marybank. In Marybank turn right and follow the road signposted "Strathconon/Scatwell". Continue along this road for approximately twelve miles passing through Dalnacroich, past the Primary School and the signpost for "Strathconon Hall". Take the next right up the rough track just before the house called "Strathkyle" and the plot is on the right hand side.
